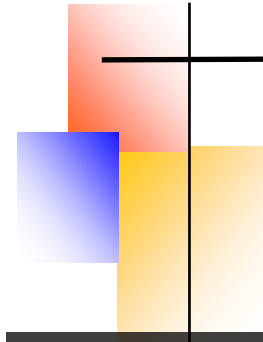

The CMS Mission

"We work with churches to set apart, equip and support long-term workers who cross cultures to share the gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ. The world is growing and changing rapidly, but the gospel of Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today and tomorrow.

Our mission is to reach Gospel-poor peoples' for Christ. Gospel-poor peoples' are people groups who have limited or no opportunity to hear the good news of Jesus Christ in their own language and cultural context without outside help. Typically, they will be people groups with less than 2% evangelical Christians.

In these parts of the world, CMS missionaries engage in evangelism and church planting, partnering with local churches wherever possible. We also send people with specialist skills to witness in word and deed, and through ministries of compassion. In our increasingly mobile world, there are many opportunities to reach gospel-poor peoples in diaspora communities, including refugees. We are open to going wherever the Spirit of God leads, but focus on gospel-poor people groups among Muslim and Buddhist peoples, and historically Catholic Europe.

We praise God for the extraordinary numerical growth of his Church around the world, especially in Asia, Africa and Latin America. This growth has created great needs in discipleship, Bible training and leadership development. In these parts of the world, we partner with churches and Christian organisations to train and mentor Christian leaders, prioritising those places where the need is most urgent and local resources are lacking. "
