The Final Battle

The ancients in various parts of the world tended to see time and history in one of two ways; that is either cyclical or linear. The ancient Greeks are a great example of the former as were many polytheistic cultures. They looked at the seasons and viewed everything through the eyes of that endless and ongoing cycle of change. They observed the constant coming and going of one generation after another, the 'seasons' in communities and societies. The scriptures and the ancient Hebrews also appreciated these cycles as seen in Ecclesiastes for example.

On the other hand though the Hebrews also understood that history is essentially linear with a beginning, a middle and end that governs all things. The creation has a clear and distinct beginning then reaches something of a high point in the life of Christ and is steadily moving to its end of renewal and restoration. Today we look at the beginning of that end, the end of evil and all it brings, the end of corruption, injustice and brokenness. We all long for such an end but it is only through Christ that such an end will come, God's word of both judgment upon all evil including our own and of mercy for all who come in faith. The decision is whether we accept these things will end on God's terms, not ours.
