

THE BIGGER PICTURE

Today's reading touches in part on the temple tax. It was a tax that enabled the Jewish religious leaders to maintain and run the temple. The temple at its best was a powerful visible symbol of God's presence with his people and of the covenant he made with them that began long ago with Abraham and continued on through the centuries. The temple Matthew refers to was the second temple built in Ezra and Nehemiah's day and extensively extended by the Herods. Unlike the first temple God's active presence was not manifest. Matthew also reminds us that God is now present with his people in the person of his Son Jesus Christ.

Nonetheless Jesus followed the protocols of the day and paid the temple tax through this miraculous provision. Through the ages churches, and more to the point denominations, had held a similar practice, which the Anglican Church is called Assessment. It enables the Diocese or the wider denomination to function. At times it might seem like an uncomfortable and unnecessary headache but it also saves us a massive amount of work in regard to things like insurance, employment arrangements, maintenance and so forth. To ignore such things also has its dangers. Individual churches that are not connected to other churches or a wider structure, such as a church that used to be in Carnarvon, run the risk of becoming genuine sects or fringe groups that do more harm than good.

An obvious point of concern is that such structures and provisions can become corrupt and self-serving as it was in Jesus' day but that's why we have Synods and the like, whatever name each denomination gives them. Psalm 122 called faithful Jews to pray for Jerusalem. We need to pray for the church and for the gospel to continue to sound forth from its leaders and, where we need to, fight to keep declaring the good news of Jesus Christ.
