

## The Resurrection - An Affirmation of Life

The lead character of Shakespeare's Hamlet described death as the 'Undiscovered Country', Tolkien wrote of the Elves of Tolkien's Middle-earth travelling to the 'Grey Havens'. As Psalm 49 reminds us we know death is a part of life that is inescapable. Nonetheless for many death at some level is something we dare not speak of or think about, or with frequent phone calls from insurance companies something some simply desire to cash in on. People spend their time and energy on the illusion of perpetual youth, of self-help and personal development or building personal empires or reputations by which we will be forever remembered, or we live in a constant state of fear of pain and death succumbing to depression and despair.

The events of Easter speak powerfully of the reality of death but also of life, especially eternal life. The resurrection is the divine affirmation of life in all of its fullness and richness physically and spiritually. For many death is disturbing in the face of final judgment, a judgment we ignore or forestall or deny, but for those who believe death truly is a doorway through which we pass as we enter into the presence of God, forgiven, redeemed, justified and sanctified.

More than that the Resurrection affirms for us what is to come, the glory of the risen Jesus that will be ours on the last day when heaven and earth meet. This is why, in the face of issues that involved the willful termination of life whether early on or near the end, Christians have traditionally affirmed life or have been involved in professions that affirm and fight for life.
