

Who Wrote 1 John?

1 John, like many of the books of the New Testament has been around since the end of the first century. Unlike most of the New Testament though it lacks the traditional greeting by the author to his recipients. The early church fathers at the end of the first century spoke of two Johns, John the Apostle and John the elder. The former was understood to be the author of the Gospel of John and of 1 John. In the second century, 1 John was also understood to have been a letter written by John the Apostle. There are two features of the letter itself that lend authenticity to this suggestion. Firstly the letter begins with the account that the writer was an eyewitness to Jesus including his resurrection and ascension. Secondly so much of the theology of this letter such as his understanding of God as light and love take us back to John's Gospel especially John 1 and John 14-17. As a result I take the author of this letter to be John the Apostle.
