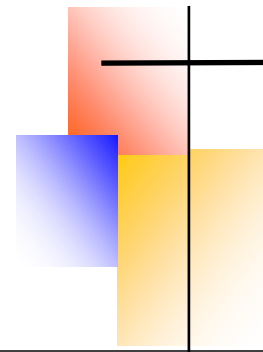

WHENCE FORTH DOES JUSTICE COME?

Today we look at a Psalm written by King David that is the first of four that look at faith, sinfulness, righteousness, justice and judgment amongst other things. In these Psalms he is mindful of his own brokenness as well as the brokenness of others. He writes of his suffering and troubles and of the call to godliness and selflessness for God in contrast to the coldness and selfishness of his enemies around him. David wrestles with the question of justice as many did long ago and do so today.

For Christians what should be the key foundations for how we see and work for justice? Above all else the scriptures remind us justice is grounded in the transcendent, in principles beyond the physical real of space-time. In a time where so much is determined by popular opinion, wealthy, ruthless and influential power brokers or focus groups, in a world where some see the universe we live in as all there is, a product of no more than chance, the scriptures tell us justice is founded in something greater. They are not just grounded in eternal virtues but in the eternal God who brought all things into being. They reflect and spring forth from God's holy, loving and righteous character manifest in his works of creation and salvation.

Jesus comes as the one expressing and enabling true justice at its heart. He exhibits and enables divine justice socially, physically and spiritually, dying to atone for the supreme injustice that was and is our rejection of the creator. Through the inauguration and eventual complete coming of his Kingdom the breakdown of order and relationship will be finally dealt with by God. So we look forward to that day as David did when God's will be done on earth as it is in heaven.
