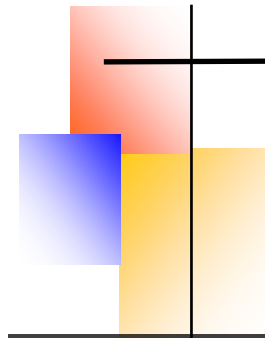

Old Church — New Life

21st July 2019

Even the Winds and Waves!

Matthew's gospel suggests that the disciples went out onto the Sea of Galilee at least twice. It would have been a quicker way to cross that region rather than walk all the way around. We know the storms the gospels describe were and are still not uncommon as winds blow and stir up the lake. Such storms in the ancient world were also seen to have a spiritual cause, often a dark and dangerous one at that. In polytheistic religions the god(s) of the sea were amongst the most powerful. Even today experienced mariners know just how dangerous the sea can be. It may well be for this reason the picture at the end of Revelation of the New Jerusalem explicitly mentions no sea whatsoever.

More than all of that though the picture of the disciples in the boat in the middle of a storm served as a picture of the early church tossed about by the waves of persecution. In both situations their very lives were in danger, but in both situations they had reason to persevere and find courage as the Christ stood in the middle of both storms, unmoved, constant, enduring. Matthew's account becomes all the more intriguing as Peter is encouraged to step out in the middle of this storm to walk with Jesus on the water. How often fear distracts us or weakens us or at worst paralyzes us. It may well be that true faith and courage show themselves especially when the church is under the pump and in danger of being overwhelmed. In the face of an increasingly hostile culture it's time to capture again this picture of Jesus, at peace, calm and confident calming the storm around his disciples as we follow him.

Our Place In The Kingdom

Karrinyup Anglican Church will be having a MORNING TOGETHER on Saturday 27th July from 9.30 to 12.30 to enable us to have fellowship around the Word of God, and to learn from one of Western Australia's best known and loved Evangelical teachers, David Seccombe.

After providing significant leadership to St Matthew's Anglican Church in Shenton Park, David moved, nearly 30 years ago, to Cape Town, South Africa, to be Principal of George Whitefield College, which has been a crucial centre for the equipping of gospel workers across Africa. David is adding to his already extensive body of works expounding the Bible. He has published a book called *The Gospel of the Kingdom: Jesus' Revolutionary Message*, and is currently working on a new work focusing on the books of Luke and Acts.

The focus of David's teaching at our Morning Together will be on the Kingdom of God, which was one of Jesus' key areas of teaching, expounded both in parables and in his teaching on prayer. In particular, David will lead us to see what our place in the Kingdom is.

The morning together will be chaired by our rector, Michael. It will include morning tea, an interview, and two talks by David.
