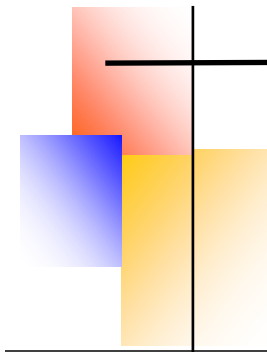

## JUDGES: GOD IN DANGEROUS TIMES

For the next few weeks we will be looking at most of the book of Judges. It's a book that historically tells us what happened to Israel after settling in the Promised Land under Joshua up until the time of Samuel and the start of the Monarchy. It is not meant to be a comprehensive history but rather it gets to the theological heart of the struggle in Israel's early days as they kept falling prey to idolatry and judgment, having failed to completely take the land. Yet through it all we see that God's grace was quietly but powerfully manifest.

Reading Judges is not easy. It was a dangerous time with heroes and heroines of faith, many of whom were as flawed as people can be. It's a book deliberately full of irony, funny in one verse, appalling in the next. We see faith and fickleness, devotion and distraction, courage and fear. The book is deliberately framed so that it seems chaos increasingly begins to reign supreme, yet even towards the end God's grace and mercy are manifest to those with eyes to see. It's meant to show us a time when Israel was in very real danger of abandoning the covenant with God made under Moses and Joshua, when their knowledge of God and the law and the covenant slowly dissipated as previous generations forgot or stopped passing that knowledge onto the next as they were meant to.

Indeed the reason why I want to look at this book is that I think we live in a similar time where our culture has lost or is at risk of losing its knowledge of God in general and specific ways, of a church that is succumbing to a neo-paganism and aggressive secularism that threatens to pull us away from Christ. In the judges we see lessons to be learnt as to the challenge of faith and responding to grace in a graceless and self-indulgent age that will hopefully strengthen and empower us.
