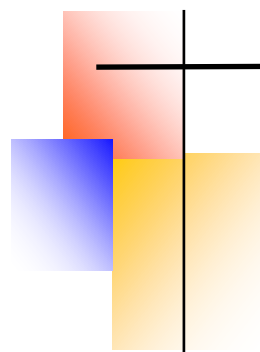

## WHAT IS TRUTH?

A few years ago a trusted colleague spoke about Deuteronomy 29:29 "The secret things belong to the LORD our God, but those things which are revealed belong to us and to our children forever, that we may do all the words of this law." It's a verse that reminds me of the nature of divine revelation. Francis Shaeffer the noted apologist spoke of the truths revealed in scripture as real truth but not exhaustive truth. God is and can never be completely understood. So when we speak of God or the Lord Jesus Christ being hidden, it's because in essence God is so much greater than us. We can be confident in what we know but humbly understand there is much we will never know.

In contrast we see the worldly counter that is deception and lies. Truths can be twisted, hidden, only partly revealed in order to maintain control or gain or keep power and influence. As human beings who are flawed and damaged we almost can't help ourselves whether in arrogance or fear to play fast and loose with the truth. We know the truth is not a monolithic notion. We see the same things with different eyes and different perspectives, but we also know in reality, life and relationships truth exists and matters.

Today I touch on the notion of conspiracy as we see such things on the rise in the western world on this Sunday in the church calendar that reflects on Christ the King. Many conspiracies are a nonsense, others are true. Some are petty and others matters are of great concern, but one danger is in rejecting the authority of those involved in a supposed conspiracy we have to accept the authority of others who speak against it. As we wrestle with such things and find ourselves tempted to give in to such things, the question is in the end: Who will we fear and who will we trust? I chose to trust in Christ the King.
