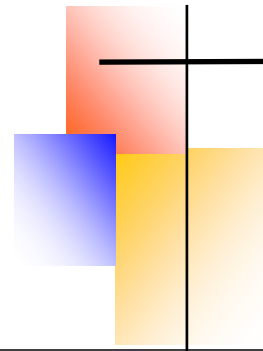

Old Church - New Life

YOU EAT WHAT? YOU DRINK WHAT?

We have all experienced someone or we have said something so provocative the response is a collective 'WHAAAAT'. 'Did they just say that?' Today we look at the heart of Jesus' teaching on his being the Bread of Life. It's an idea that provokes essentially the same reaction. For those of us who have grown up in the church or been a part of the church for many years the language of eating Jesus' body and drinking his blood is something we're quite comfortable with. At its heart we know what we're talking about as a spiritual act, an act of faith.

We forget though that the idea here that was carried onto our understanding of the Lord's Supper was very challenging for Jesus' first hearers. For an orthodox Jew to eat a person and to drink blood were both gross violations of the law of Moses. When the church spread throughout the Roman Empire the shock continued and Roman apologists who spoke against Christians accused them of cannibalism.

Today we have generations rising up who again have no idea about these things, marks of the widespread biblical illiteracy that marks generations Y and Z. Two of our church members have their own grandchildren ask if they were cannibals when they talked about Holy Communion. This is why I am asking us to consider the future of KAC, of being a church that is truly missional, looking out especially towards the upcoming generations so that they can understand and believe the truth of Jesus' words here and believe in the gospel and one day partake of the Lord's Supper with understanding as opposed to seeing it as weird on the one hand and eating a funny white wafer and wine on the other. It is what it is, a great gift to God's people because it points us to Christ, the greatest gift God gave us along with the Holy Spirit.
