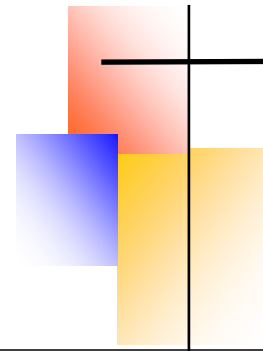

GOING HOME

When I was learning the piano long ago one of the pieces I played was the melody from Dvorak's New World symphony called 'Going Home'. Our beloved brother Graham is home, dying peacefully this last Monday evening. The last few years from Graham have been so very hard, especially 2020. His trials pushed many of us to pray like never before. He would recover from one challenge and then promptly face another. Thankfully now those trials are over and we know he is home and at peace with the Lord.

Graham's story brings to mind for me the story of Job and of those passages that uncomfortably remind us that trials and struggles and temptations become moments when we can grow in faith, in hope, in godliness and in patience. We would all rather it were not so, but that is one of those paradoxes that marks the human condition. We may suffer for a multitude of reasons as a consequence of our or others foolishness but sometimes there is no obvious reason why we suffer as there wasn't for Job but we do nonetheless.

The story of Job and his suffering also opens up for us the possibility of an innocent person suffering unjustly for a higher purpose. It opens the door to our Lord's suffering as God's innocent servant who gave his life in our place so that we might live, the guilty forgiven and reconciled to God. God calls us to respond to this hope in faith as Graham did when he was baptised and confirmed about 30 years ago. We know Graham is home because of that faith, that faith that struggled but ultimately with God's help overcame those struggles. Graham has been a quiet but steadfast member of KAC for many years and his mark has been well and truly left on this church. We will miss him, but we thank God for his faith, his service, his dedication and his mindfulness and commit him into his Shepherd's care.

COVID REQUIREMENTS FROM DIOCESE

- * 2 sqm rule and 75% patron maximum capacity is removed
- * Masks no longer mandatory while indoors at church but if you for any reason prefer to still wear one please do so. That is simply a matter of choice.
- * Hospitals and Residential aged care and disability care facilities -
 - Masks must still be worn
 - two visitors per patient per day (except for compassionate reasons and essential visitors)
 - Visitors still required to show proof of vaccination
- * Practice good hygiene at all times, on entering the building and before taking communion especially
- * Be mindful during the greeting of the peace of other's preferences especially if they prefer not to make physical contact with others.
- * The collection at both services will happen by means of placing one's gift in the basket up front.
- * If anyone feels unwell or at risk, stay home and if need be get tested ASAP
- * Keep alert for state government requirements.
