POWER AND ITS ABUSES Pt 2 – WAR & OPPRESSION

Over the year I have met people who think King Saul got a raw deal. Indeed one man suggested God maliciously set him up. So what was wrong with Saul? Saul soon forgot as king that his kingship was grounded in God's rule and that even he was answerable to God's laws and the Covenant made with Israel. Instead he became a king like the nations around him and used his power without regard for God's laws or the benefit of the people of Israel. David, at his worst, become such a king as this for a little while. Many of the kings of Judah and Israel follow in Saul's footsteps and forget they serve God the great King. Ahab was undoubtedly amongst the worst of these kings as seen in the wars that threaten Israel and in the appalling land grab as he essentially steals Naboth's Vineyard.

Over the millennia little has changed as we see people in power abuse it for their own benefit at the expense of the people. Even in Australia political, economic and religious leaders have done much the same within their particular purview. The scriptures remind us that good leadership recognises God's character and laws as the King over all as both the model for their leadership and the limiting factor on theirs. This was the reasoning behind the Magna Carta, Constitutions, Parliaments and so forth. That are fundamental and transcendental principles grounded in the divine that enable leadership to be exercised in such a way that it is for the benefit of all, not some. When leadership within the church or community fails to do so, there must and will be a reckoning when justice will be done as it was towards Saul and Ahab.

COVID-19 UPDATE

1. We can now have up to 100 people attend provided we keep 1.5 metres apart from each other aside from couples and families. The chairs will be spaced accordingly. Communion will still be of one kind and good hygiene should be maintained before, during, between and after services. We will refrain from physical contact for the sharing of the Peace for the time being.
2. Again, if you are not well and suffering from any kind of respiratory illness or are at risk, consider staying home. Services will be streamed for a little longer.
