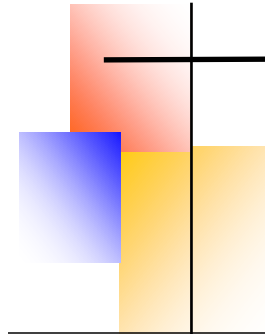

Old Church — New Life

A CHANGE OF CLOTHES AND MORE

Almost thirty years ago I bought my Leinster school cardigan and it still gets used in Autumn and Spring. It belongs with some other old clothes that are innately comfortable, in which I relax. We all have such clothes we slip on without thinking. On the other hand, we also love to dress up and a wedding day is one such perfect opportunity. We buy new clothes or hire something flash and attractive and can't wait to find that moment to wear it and show it off. In today's world, clothes and fashion are a matter of taste and style preference but they can also tell us something about the person who wears them. Uniforms are an obvious example though more generally they indicate income and personal prosperity.

In the ancient world, one's clothes said a great deal not just about one's income but one's status and position within society. They were a way of communicating one's class and station within a community. You wore certain clothes for certain occasion which forms the background to the parable of the wedding banquet. It also is vital as background to Paul's picture as he writes about sanctification, putting off the old life, living in the flesh as he describes it elsewhere and putting on the new, living in the Spirit. They indicate a fundamental change in our status thanks to the Lord Jesus Christ. The old clothes dirty and impure marred by sin and self are replaced with the new clothes pure and holy thanks to the righteousness of Christ. So today is an opportunity to consider, to thank God for and recommit to the ever-present task of changing clothes, new for old, as we look forward to all we have and will have in Christ, growing in his likeness, in godliness and purity to his glory.

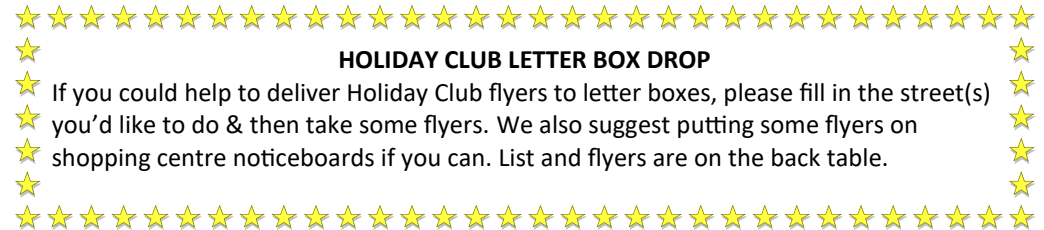
