LIVING WITH HOPE FOR THE FUTURE

This next few weeks following Easter and leading up to Pentecost is called Eastertide so we're going to finish looking at the book of Acts. It's also a chance to focus on the mission of the Church. The life and work of Christ is not something we remember only at Christmas and Easter. He is the foundation for our very life. Likewise mission is not something we think about every so often. It's an essential component to the life of the church and Christians but for the moment we can focus our attention on that call to proclaim Christ.

Mission also arises from the conviction that Jesus' resurrection is not the end but rather the beginning, our future age breaking into the present age. The world struggles with the brokenness, suffering and evil of the present age and eventually succumbs to a naïve utopianism like the kind in Star Trek or into a dystopian nightmare like George Orwell's 1984. Rather despite the madness we see in our world, God, through Jesus will usher in a new age when evil and sin are a memory. That hope begins with Jesus' resurrection and ascension.
