Old Church — New Life

23rd August 2020

A DEFINING MOMENT

Today Ian will look at John's record of Jesus' entry into the temple in John 2. The placement of this incident has been a puzzle for scholars for a very long time. The other gospels place it immediately after Jesus' entry into Jerusalem a week before his resurrection whereas John places it early in Jesus' public ministry. This can matter as there are those who suggest it shows the bible is an unreliable historical document that can't be trusted.

Over the years a few solutions to this puzzle have been proposed. One less popular solution is that Jesus entered into the temple to cleanse it twice. John has recorded the first entry early in Jesus' ministry while the others recorded the second entry. Another is that the incident happened early in Jesus' ministry and the other gospel writers chose to place it late in his ministry. Most likely John placed the event early in his gospel.

We forget the gospel writers primarily wrote the gospels are theological documents to persuade their readers that Jesus was the Christ, the Son of God who has come into the world to save it. Historical and chronological considerations are secondary. They are not writing a strict history but rather a gospel about Jesus as the Christ. John probably placed this incident early in the gospel, because he recognized just how significant and defining it was in telling us about Jesus' ministry. Given what he has told the reader that Jesus is the Word that dwelt among us, John makes clear that Jesus is the new 'temple' God with his people. This reality is crucial to his ministry and mission. This too is that good news we share as we ask people to come and see Jesus.

COVID-19 UPDATE
