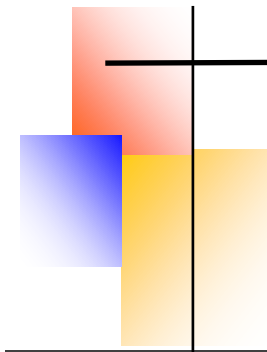

Jesus' Return – Watching, Waiting, Doing

When I was living with my parents, at the end of our street lived a single mum with her son who befriended my younger brother. It was not a particularly helpful relationship for him as this boy was left to his own devices. The mum spent most of her time writing on the pavement or on the windows of the house, almost all of it about the Lord's return. That is not how Jesus wants us to await his return. We imagine waiting for him is a bit like waiting in a doctor's surgery, reading magazines, looking at our phone and passing the time.

Instead Jesus calls us to wait and watch but we do so by doing, by living, loving, speaking and serving. The great saints in the New Testament and throughout Church History understand that faith bears fruit as we follow Christ. Some do mission work, some community service, some serve in the manner of their professionalism in the workplace and some serve in full time Christian ministry, ordained or otherwise. We wait and watch prayerfully, humbly and faithfully. We do it for Jesus, with Jesus and through Jesus.

We also do so without getting too caught up on when. I liken waiting for Jesus to being students in the classroom when the teacher leaves the room. We can either muck up hoping the teacher won't return before we're done, or we just get on with the work we've been given. If we do the former, we have every reason to dread the teacher's return but if we get on with it, their return only brings commendation. So we serve looking forward to that great day when Jesus gathers up his faithful disciples.
