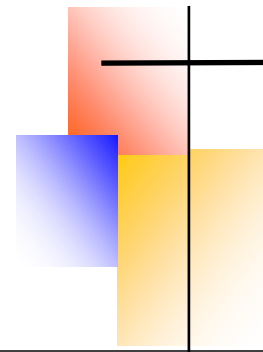

## Come and Meet Jesus!

Modern society has inherited an important legal legacy that came out of our Christian and grace-roman heritage. The scriptures heartily commend the import for two or more witnesses in any trial (Deut 17:6) and Roman law insisted on the right of the accused to meet and confront their accusers (see Acts 25:16). Witness plays an important part in John's gospel as Jesus preaches the kingdom of God and the gift of eternal life in his name. Today's passage sees Jesus corral a number of witnesses both human and divine who corroborate his claim to be the Messiah, the Son of God. As we read through the gospel we see that one of the key roles for the apostles and early church with the help of the Holy Spirit will be that of witness.

In Acts we see the church, its leaders and Christians being witnesses to Jesus's death and resurrection and his being the Messiah, the Son of God. Not all are called to be mini evangelists but we are called to pray for and give towards mission and to give a reason for the hope that is within us as the need arises. The church is called to be witnesses and are whether we like it or not. Jesus makes the choice starkly clear: "You are the light of the world. A city set on a hill cannot be hidden. Nor do people light a lamp and put it under a basket, but on a stand, and it gives light to all in the house. In the same way, let your light shine before others, so that they may see your good works and give glory to your Father who is in heaven." (Matt 5:14-16). We either choose to hide the light or let it shine.

As we move forward whatever the troubles that befall us, whatever the challenges that rise up to meet us and whatever those of the darkness in and out of the church say to us, we too must consider anew, will we let our light shine for Christ and ask people to come and meet Jesus?
