The Kingdom and Prayer

At the moment we are working through some of the parables Jesus taught that are recorded in Matthew. They're parables that speak primarily about the Kingdom of Heaven or God, its nature, its priority, its growth. The coming of God's kingdom in Christ is a work of god, of sovereign grace. There is nothing we can do to bring about or speed up its coming. Nonetheless we pray for God's Kingdom to come. Prayer is an integral part of the life of the disciple who is a member of this Kingdom.

God calls us to participate in the life of the kingdom in prayer, praying for it to break forth in the lives of the people around us, in our community and throughout the world as people hear the gospel of Jesus and respond in heartfelt repentance and faith. Prayer is necessary not because it is a means by which we can gain God's favour but as the means by which we express our ongoing dependence upon our Heavenly Father who gives us life and strength as members of the Kingdom. The church of God is not the same as the Kingdom of God. Rather it is the gathering of Gods people but it is one of the key ways in which God's kingdom finds expression in word and deed here on earth. That is our privilege and responsibility.
