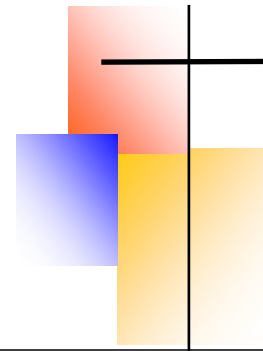

EASTERTIDE & MISSION

Eastertide is that season in the church calendar that begins with Easter Sunday and ends with the Ascension and is affirmed in the wonderful liturgical words "Christ is Risen", "He is Risen indeed". We are going to look at some of the book of Acts that describes for us the mission of Christ that continues in the Spirit filled and empowered Church led by the apostles. It continues to bear witness to the crucified, risen and ascended Christ.

They and we are empowered by God to bear witness in word and deed to the hope we have in Christ. In Acts we read of remarkable conversions, powerful sermons and astonishing miracles and answers to prayers. Peter, Stephen, Paul and others also remind us of the cost that comes in following and proclaiming Christ as they face death or die like Stephen and James for their faith.

Last year I asked us to consider making changes to our service times which we did and did so wholeheartedly. This is only a first step. The church will only truly collectively grow by faithfully bearing witness to the gospel no matter the cost. We won't grow by modifying our theology and practice to accommodate the whims of the world. It will not grow primarily through clever marketing and modern technology. These tools can help us to a point but we were made for relationship in God and it is through relationship that God works to save and who revealed himself fully as Father, Son and Holy Spirit.

We now need to ask ourselves as a church what our next step will be. Mission is a task given to the Church as a whole. God calls evangelists and missionaries who serve with the support of the church. Nonetheless we ALL have a part to play and that will take faith and courage but when we see that and act something wonderful can happen.
