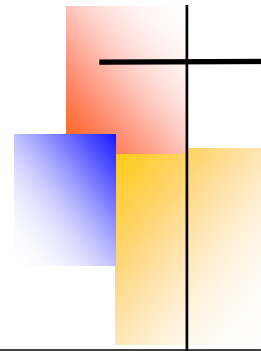

TALKING ABOUT GOD!

Today as we look at the start of the Apostle's and Nicene Creeds, we look at the first line, "I believe in (the one) God, the Father Almighty. To talk about God as father has been increasingly provocative over the last decade or two. For some of us, our experience of our human fathers especially has been anything but good. It is easy to take our grief or rage over our human parents and dump them onto God. In other quarters in light of modern so-called theories about gender fluidity and the like such language is dismissed as patriarchal, isolating and exclusive. In a postmodern world where our understanding of language and experience has changed what do we do?

Firstly we need to remember that when we speak of the triune God, of who he is and what he has done, we can almost only use analogies. So given we were made in God's image as male and female, masculinity and femininity, fatherhood and motherhood have their roots in God. God the Father is not literally an old man sitting on a throne in heaven as a human king would be. I once spoke to a young man about Genesis 1 who believed God walked as a man in the garden with a physical body. We reduce the creator to some aspect of his creation which is idolatry.

Secondly though we need to remember that divine revelation is authoritative. God has chosen to reveal himself as Father, Son and Holy Spirit. If we use bad childhood experiences as an excuse to call God 'mother' or the Holy Spirit 'she', we presume to know better than divine revelation and sit over it. That is blasphemous and idolatrous in my view. Such traumas need to be dealt with by experienced and suitable counsellors and with the help of the Holy Spirit to truly understand who we are in light of who God is and what he has and is doing for us.

COVID REQUIREMENTS FROM DIOCESE
