Slowly Returning to Normal Pt 2

As we prepare to return to church here at KAC I need to remind you of some the conditions we need to meet for the next three weeks as restrictions slowly lift. Given the restrictions we are conducting a 5.00pm service along with the two morning services. Firstly please remember to indicate you're coming to church, to one of the three services, ahead of time by using the [TryBooking](#) link or ringing Karen during office hours. Please make Karen the first port of call to contact by phone rather than me as I have enough on my plate at the moment. To reopen so to speak I am required to fill in a COVID-19 action plan. In that plan we need to demonstrate we can follow 5 key guidelines that are 1) Social/ Physical distancing; 2) A maximum of 20 people excluding those directly involved with the service; 3) A record of those who attend for the purpose of contact tracing; 4) Maintain waiting areas to ensure the distancing is maintained and 5) Good Hygiene especially for those involved in the service.

This means in the detail that Holy Communion will be of one kind, the Greeting of the Peace will be at a distance except for family members and people will be spaced out around the church no closer than 1.5-2m from each other except for family members. Morning Tea will be a simple affair with do it yourself tea and coffee. For the next three weeks the only food to be eaten will be something that comes in packs so that only those eating touch the food. Prepared food will add another layer that I want to avoid for the moment. Once again I want to remind people that if you are not well, in an at risk group or have children who will struggle with the concept of social distancing you might want to hold off returning to church until June. We will not be resuming the Sunday School program until phase 3 is brought in. Streaming of the 9.30 service will continue for the moment. Keep safe and God bless.
