

THE END IS NIGH?

The Second Coming
BY WILLIAM BUTLER YEATS

*Turning and turning in the widening gyre
The falcon cannot hear the falconer;
Things fall apart; the centre cannot hold;
Mere anarchy is loosed upon the world,
The blood-dimmed tide is loosed, and everywhere
The ceremony of innocence is drowned;
The best lack all conviction, while the worst
Are full of passionate intensity.*

*Surely some revelation is at hand;
Surely the Second Coming is at hand.
The Second Coming! Hardly are those words out
When a vast image out of Spiritus Mundi
Troubles my sight: somewhere in sands of the desert
A shape with lion body and the head of a man,
A gaze blank and pitiless as the sun,
Is moving its slow thighs, while all about it
Reel shadows of the indignant desert birds.
The darkness drops again; but now I know
That twenty centuries of stony sleep
Were vexed to nightmare by a rocking cradle,
And what rough beast, its hour come round at last,
Slouches towards Bethlehem to be born?*

This is a poem that has been quoted an astonishing amount of times, especially in recent years. It was written in 1919 after WW1, the Russian Revolution and in the midst of the Spanish Flu pandemic, in a time of great fear and despair. Judah found themselves in such a situation 2600 year ago when all seemed lost. We too fear the rough beast will reach Bethlehem but over the millenia it never has. In Christ we know better days will come and the evil will come to an end. We live not with despair but with hope in him.
