THE WILD MAN OF JUDAH

I often say that if I could have a handful of people from history come to dinner, one on my list would be John the Baptist (I'll have to learn how to fry locusts!). He is a man driven by one overwhelming passion and commitment that was proclaiming the coming of God's Kingdom and his Messiah. The call to repentance and change was bold, brash and uncompromising.

In a world full of distractions he is a confronting and unsettling figure. We can try to dismiss him as a basket case, a fanatic or fundamentalist but he stands in a long line of prophets whose encounter with the transcendent God forever changed them and gave them a strength and courage most do not have. At the heart of his ministry lies a profound understanding of God's holiness, that is his transcendence above and over humanity and creation and his absolute purity and righteousness. In a world marked by shades of grey, we are challenged by the God who is only light. In grace and mercy, he interacts with broken and sinful people without compromising his purity. Both John and Jesus demonstrate this in their radicalness and unwillingness to compromise on the things of God. May we find the wisdom, courage and faith to do likewise in his name.
