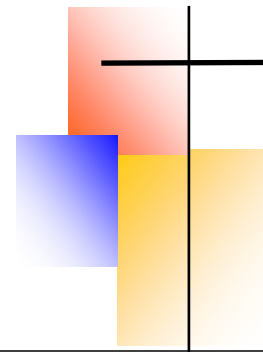

Eternity in our Hearts

The teacher of Ecclesiastes wisely reminds us that 'He (God) has made everything beautiful in its time. Also, he has put eternity into man's heart, yet so that he cannot find out what God has done from the beginning to the end. (Eccl 3:11)'. It's another way of talking about our being made in God's image or likeness. Unlike every other living thing on earth we are spiritual beings. We're aware of and long for connection with the transcendent.

Since the enlightenment some have suggested that another name for human beings may well be 'homo religiosus', the religious human. For millennia human beings across the world, in every corner of the world, worshipped something(s) whether gods and goddesses, spirits and powers who shaped our lives for good or ill. Atheism as we understand it today was simply a nonsense. Yet even now we send probes throughout the solar system in hopes we'll find signs of life, past or present, somewhere to know we're not alone. Something seemingly greater than ourselves will always compel our devotion and energy and passion. For all our advances we still adore the gods of power, pleasure, things and self as if they can provide us with the validation we crave.

All these things remind us that we were made for worship, living with the one true creator God at the centre of all we are and do, the God revealed to us in God the Son, Jesus Christ and by the Holy Spirit. We are not alone in the seemingly existential void. We ARE known and loved, and we are called to response to our gracious God in worship in all we say and do in the name of Christ and by the Spirit. Does he compel our devotion and faith or are we too at risk of placing another false God on the throne of our lives.
