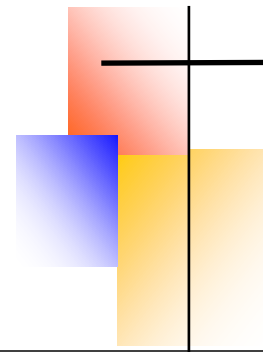

KINGDOMS TEMPORAL AND ETERNAL!

One of the most enduring of English stories is the legend of King Arthur, immortalised in numerous books, movies and TV shows. At its heart a young man becomes the king of England and strives to unify a divided land as he establishes the Summer Kingdom. For a time he succeeds with the help of his Knights but it does not last. His half-sister Morgana ultimately succeeds in bringing his reign to an end in a climactic battle. It's a powerful reminder of the reality that empires, kingdoms and civilizations rise and fall over time.

Over the next few weeks we will look at the book of 1 Kings. It starts so well as Solomon becomes king, a good and wise king who builds the temple for God as promised to his Father David. It is as close as we get to a golden age for Israel that does not last. Before long, like Gideon, Solomon starts so well but ends poorly. The kingdom splits into two kingdoms, the idolatry that will mark Israel to the north and before long we see the rise of the great prophets Elijah and the wretched king Ahab. We will read of grace and mercy, cruelty and injustice, of droughts natural and spiritual and of war and peace.

Thankfully we know there is a kingdom, the spiritual kingdom that began with the coming of the King, the Messiah, our Lord Jesus Christ. In the books of the Kings we will see glimmers of what God's kingdom will be like and much of what it will never be. In a world that still struggles with injustice and war, of corrupt and selfish leaders both political and spiritual, we continue to long for and pray 'Maranatha', come Lord Jesus come.

HOW TO BOOK FOR THE THREE SUNDAY SERVICES 8AM 9:30AM & 5PM

- You can register on <https://www.trybooking.com/BJRAQ> It is a simple process.
- Registrations are open from Mondays to Saturdays before each Sunday service and no registrations can be made on the day of the service. We will keep a record of attendance to be safe.
- If you can't register online and you want to attend you can register through the church office 9341 5572 Monday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday before 12 noon only.

COVID-19 UPDATE

1. Sunday services can still be accessed through our new Facebook page 'Karrinyup Anglican Church Services'. Request an invitation if you are on Facebook and Kevin can give you access. The sermons are still available in audio as well.
2. We can now have up to 100 people attend provided we keep 1.5 metres apart from each other aside from couples and families. The chairs will be spaced accordingly. Communion will still be of one kind and good hygiene should be maintained before, during, between and after services. We will refrain from physical contact for the sharing of the Peace for the time being.
3. Again, if you are not well and suffering from any kind of respiratory illness or are at risk, consider staying home. Services will be streamed for a little longer.
