An Unhelpful Emphasis?

When I was a younger man it seemed that one of my main priorities was to get married. Almost all of my friends were married and without a girlfriend in sight I began to wonder what was wrong with me. Not long before going out with Alison God reminded me of a wonderful truth: In Christ, as a human being and man I am whole as I am. In the church we rightly affirm the importance of traditional marriage and fight tooth and nail for it but we risk sending the unhelpful message that to be single is to be incomplete in some way.

If that was so then of course our Lord would be incomplete, which is nonsense. Jesus was wonderfully and fully human. We fall into this trap because we understand marriage to be a wonderful example of the intimacy two people can enjoy. Jesus though his relationship with the Father experienced an intimacy beyond compare, even for the married. We can experience that intimacy to a degree with God by faith in Christ through the Spirit whether married or single.

John's Gospel is clear that by Faith in Christ we all participate in the very life of God, Father, Son and Spirit. The moment those of us who are married unwittingly patronise or marginalize our single brethren we only do them a disservice. Rather we pray for and encourage each other in the love of God we all experience in Christ.

Last Sunday afternoon we had a lovely time here at KAC listening to our dear friend Rob Sproule and his Barber Shop Quartet, Good News Singers, singing many of the classic, faithful hymns of old. At times we were asked to join in the singing but it was uplifting to just sit back and allow the four-part harmonies to penetrate the soul.

The concert was performed to raise money for PeopleAid. This is one of the Missions we support here at KAC. We have been involved with the organisation for many years in which time we have purchased Rickshaws, Market Carts and Sewing Machines which have been given to small business owners so that they have the tools of their trade and do not have to hire (at exorbitant rates) them. This means that the family have the benefit of higher wages and are able to lift themselves out of poverty, providing education for the children which was previously out of reach.

The concert raised \$781.70 for this most worthy cause. Thanks go to Rob and his wonderful band of harmonising singers.
