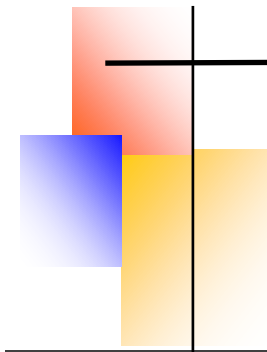

## LIGHT IN THE MIDST OF DARKNESS

Our series on the Judges comes to an end this week as we look at the climax to the story of Samson. One of the aspects of Samson's sacrificial death that takes me forward to the death of our Lord Jesus is the way at first glance it seems so hopeless. It seems that, with the help of Delilah, the Philistines have a weakened and broken Samson there to parade before their god Dagon. The reader can't help wonder if the grand signs that marked Samson's birth has come to nothing, with Israel to still suffer under the Philistines? Thankfully at the last-minute Samson cries out for help from the Lord, even if it's to exact revenge for his being blinded, and his strength returns, enough to topple two pillars as he tore down two gates, temporarily relieving Israel's oppression. Nonetheless Samson succeeds in only beginning Israel's redemption from oppression that only comes to completion under the first Messiah King David (2 Sam 8).

Jesus's death was also one marked by apparent hopelessness as his enemies mocked him at Calvary saying, "He saved others, he cannot save himself" (Mk 15:31). We know of course it's at the moment that Jesus dies that he does save us from the power of sin, death, evil and from experiencing God's just judgement on our sin. Nonetheless theologians note that the salvation we experience in Jesus has been inaugurated with Jesus' death and resurrection. We still experience that salvation as we live the Christian life by walking in the Spirit. We continue to struggle with temptation, the temptation to self-indulge or to fear or doubt and so forth. We still struggle with disease and the painful reality of death but one way when Jesus returns, he will finish what he began as David finished what Samson began.
