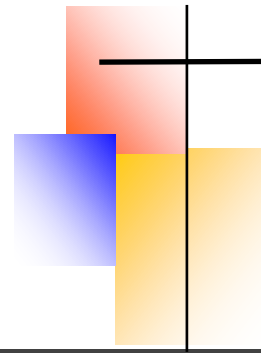

PRIORITIES AND PREOCCUPATION

How do you catch a monkey? One common idea which has become folklore in Africa is that you put a banana in a jar. The opening needs to be big enough for the monkey to get his hand in but small enough that the monkey won't be able to get the banana out while holding it. Despite their agility and nimbleness, the story goes that the monkey will refuse to let go of the banana to the point of starvation because it wants the food so badly and won't give up.

We live in a world full of things, full of distractions, and full of apparent demands that we struggle to put aside or let go of. Over the next few weeks want to look at some attitudes as Christians that ought to shape if and how we live and give and serve God, the church, and others. In August will spend the month praying for this church to grow. What will that mean for us? What might we need to do that we weren't before? What might we need to give up? What might be easier said than done as we seek to move forward?

At the AGM earlier this month the meeting rightly challenged the budget I proposed and so in that next week I sent out a modified and approved version. It's a budget that calls us to reconsider our giving anew as I know some already have. It calls us to take seriously the challenge of numerical and demographic growth and will be an exercise in faith. The COVID crisis enabled us to put these things off for a year or two as a parish, but that is now over. This budget is one with very little meat on the bone so to speak. Therefore we will take some time to look at these attitudes that mark us as faithful disciples of Christ. Love ultimately shows itself in action. How will we show our love for God, his people, and the church in the months ahead?

COVID REQUIREMENTS FROM DIOCESE

- * 2 sqm rule and 75% patron maximum capacity is removed
- * Masks no longer mandatory while indoors at church but if you for any reason prefer to still wear one please do so. That is simply a matter of choice.
- * Hospitals and Residential aged care and disability care facilities -
 - Masks must still be worn
 - two visitors per patient per day (except for compassionate reasons and essential visitors)
 - Visitors still required to show proof of vaccination
- * Practice good hygiene at all times, on entering the building and before taking communion especially
- * Be mindful during the greeting of the peace of other's preferences especially if they prefer not to make physical contact with others.
- * The collection at both services will happen by means of placing one's gift in the basket up front.
- * If anyone feels unwell or at risk, stay home and if need be get tested ASAP
- * Keep alert for state government requirements.
