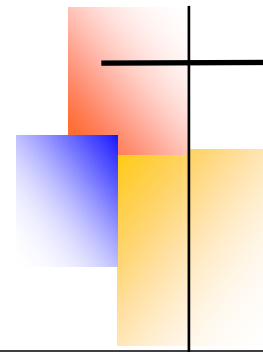

THE GOD GREATER THAN OUR HEARTS

Today's Psalm is a call to praise for all of God's people and all of creation. This last year has presented some astonishing challenges that may give us pause to wonder if we can praise God for anything or whether we even should. The climax of the Psalm reminds us that as we think about Christmas we do. God sent his beloved Son, he raise up the horn of David to save us. In the ancient world the metaphor of the horn was one of power and strength. From the start and on until the end Jesus was not someone who came across as such a figure.

Nonetheless Jesus came into the world, a broken, often hateful and self-obsessed world to bring hope, peace, love and truth. The strength Jesus showed was that of faith, godliness, of character and faithfulness, of determination and gentleness at the same time. Even as a boy his focus was on trusting, serving and loving his Father. How Jesus as a boy could be aware of his true origins we do not know but it was the driving force that led to our salvation. As we prepare to say goodbye to 2020 and look to 2021, now more than ever we need to do so mindful of the life of Christ. As we celebrate his birth, to consider all he said and did that culminates in the events of Easter.

In the midst of our grief, pain, despair, cynicism, indifference, anger or fear, we see in the Lord someone who experienced all the things we do that can lead to such states of mind. In contrast to us through as he suffered like few did, his eyes were constantly on God the Father, on his love, mercy, purposes and power to redeem paradise lost. Will we look to God the Father with such eyes of faith or not? That is a question to consider as we move into a New Year.
