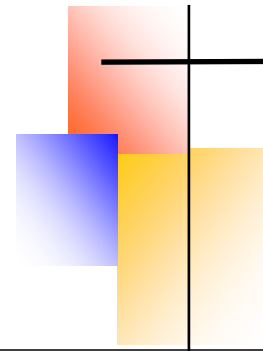

THE GIFT OF LIFE, THE REALITY OF DEATH

The last, great sign in John's gospel is the most powerful, most heart rending and rawest of them all as Jesus raises Lazarus from the dead. Death is that aspect of reality we often avoid discussing at all costs but simply can't avoid. Over this last week I have been painfully confronted by this reality yet again in grieving the unexpected death of an old friend, the impending death of a beloved church member and the needless deaths of Ukrainians in a war that is immoral, reckless and unwarranted.

Writers, theologians and scholars speak of the human condition and do so aware of the final reality of death for all of us. It is that aspect of reality that we shroud in taboos, whispers, generalities and folk mythology. People spend sizable sums of money trying to contact those who have died, living with unresolved questions and heartfelt grief. The Undiscovered Country, as Shakespeare put it, has moved playwrights, novelists, moviemakers, musicians, poets, philosophers and theologians as people wrestle with questions of life after death.

In light of this the story of Lazarus' resurrection has it all, from confusion, anger, grief, and resolve. We also see the astonishing faith of Martha and one of the great 'I am' sayings. This last sign also speaks to us of a reality that is greater, grander and more enduring than death. We know what is to come as the Lord of life came into the world and will go ahead of us as he dies on the cross bearing the sins of the world. The resurrection of Lazarus is a foretaste of what is to come for those who look to Christ. Though Lazarus would die once more, he and we look forward to the enduring resurrection we will experience in the risen Christ. In him, we find the faith, hope and courage to live in the shadow of death but even more in light of the empty tomb.
