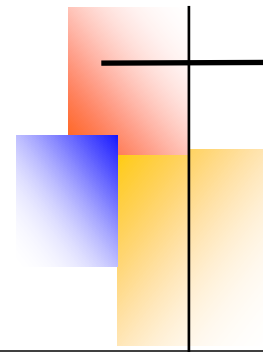

### NOTHIN' LIKE GOOD FRUIT

What's your favourite fruit? I love summer fruit especially grapes and stone fruit. Some of us love a juicy apple or pear. When we're in Carnarvon, I often enjoy a Mango smoothie at the River Gums café. We all know just how delicious a great piece of fruit can be. Of course, there's also nothing worse than fruit that goes bad whether bruised or worse. It can make us sick at the very least.

Fruit, both good and bad are powerful picture that appear in the scriptures especially grapes and vineyards. Good fruit served as a key description of the Promised Land, of its bounty and abundance. Both good and bad fruit serve as picture of Israel in the Old Testament as to what they can be at their best and what they are at their worst. Such pictures continue in the gospels and in wider New Testament. They serve as pictures of what the church and Christians can be and shouldn't be.

Both Jesus and James are clear, who we are and our actions ought to tally up and match. Paul, Peter and John also in their own way make the same point. God's character is revealed through his saving actions especially in his Son Jesus. We know God love us because he sent Jesus to save us and we know objectively Jesus loves us because he gave his life for us. Like the Israelites Christians are called to be like our Lord and Heavenly Father and if that is not the case then something is not right. Paul writes of dying to in and living for Christ. Each and every week and day we are called to consider how our faith will show itself in works that glorify God with the help of the Holy Spirit.
