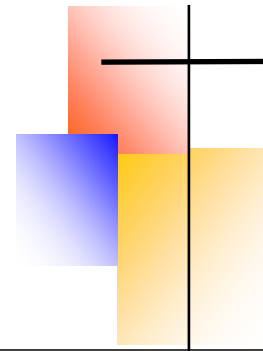

## CHALLENGING TIMES

Dear friends, this week I want to inform you of some growing concerns I and other colleagues have about some appointments that indicate the Diocese is heading in a direction I find very troubling. We need to be gracious and mindful but there are matters of great concern of which I have spoken to the Parish Council. Over the last decade or two how the church views the matter of marriage, sexuality, what constitutes sexual sin and how to proceed with regard to same-sex relationships and the like has been a growing challenge. In May the general synod of the Australian Anglican church will meet to discuss these matters. Up until that point the Australian bishops, for the most part, had agreed to hold the line so to speak about these matters and not make any changes until then.

In the last month 4 candidates were ordained to the diaconate (made deacons). Two of those are concerning as one person was in a de-facto relationship until only recently and the other is in a civil union with his same sex partner. An upcoming appointment to the Cathedral involved another man in the same situation. Both entered these unions in England according to its national legislation. I know that for some of us this will not be a matter of great concern, but I also know it is for some of us including myself.

Over the next few weeks and months in various ways I will be seeking to address these matters, make clear the reasons both theological and personal, for my concerns and how we proceed as a church in the Diocese of Perth. At this stage I am profoundly uncomfortable with where the Diocese appears to be going and how those who disagree with these matters may well be treated. I want to wrestle with how we proclaim the witness to Christ to our wider community, but these are matters we can no longer ignore.
