A BRIGHTER FUTURE?

Many years ago at a conference the speaker asked us if we thought things would get better or worse before the Lord returns. He suggested both would be true. Most people want the world to be a better and safer place. The trouble is when our focal point for the future is the human race we fall into one of two traps. The first is seen in a more dystopian or pessimistic view of the future. We dread the coming apocalypse, in whatever form it may take (and usually of our own making), it will be humanity's undoing. For many we seem determined to destroy ourselves. For others their view of the future is more utopian or optimistic. The future is bright, and the challenges and obstacles we face, both external and internal, can be overcome. We will learn and progress and improve step by step.

Revelation reminds us that both are misplaced. The first because God is greater than our foolishness and stubbornness and destructiveness and he will end and undo all the trouble we've made. He WILL bring better days. The second view because we are not God in our disposition or ability. Progress has led to both terrifying and astonishing advancements. Only God can bring lasting change to the human race and that through Jesus Christ, the perfect mediator between God and humanity.

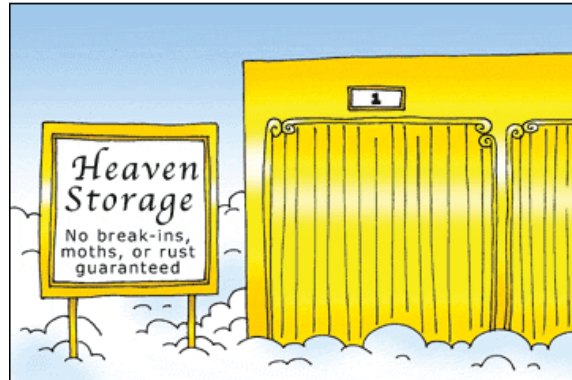
CLEANING ROSTER
