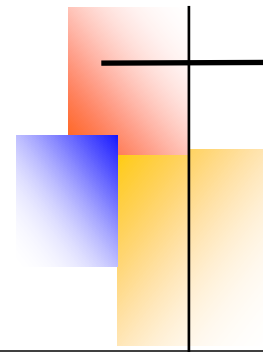

Old Church — New Life

A NEW IDENTITY

Over the years I've heard people talk about the discipline we call Theology. Sometimes we disparage the exercise as a purely human endeavour that is no more than a person exercising their opinion. Now there is some truth to that in that theology, in part, is a human endeavour. Whether one has a degree or not we all have a 'theology', a view of God and reality. Nonetheless theology is a human endeavour that wrestles with divine and therefore authoritative revelation that Christians believe we encounter in the scriptures and in the person of Jesus Christ. Both the bible and Jesus make certain claims that by faith we believe and seek to live out in our particular culture. Good theology is not just about ideas but issues forth in the way we live before God and with regard to others.

In the New Testament we see Paul draw on an important theological idea that is our being 'In Christ'. It fills and appears in all of his letters and seeks to convey something of the depth of our relationship with God in and through Jesus. We all too often reduce our faith to believing little more than that Jesus Christ died on the Cross for our sins so we can be forgiven. Our being in Christ means that and so much more. It means a whole new life in Christ. In the gospels Jesus speaks of the Kingdom, in John of New Birth. Such talk is strange to modern ears given our modern, rugged individualism but in other parts of the world and in the ancient world, one's identity was part of a greater corporate identity. So as we were dead in Adam before believing in Jesus (Rom 6, 1 Cor 15) so now we are in Christ. Over the next four weeks we will look at this theological picture and why it's so important and beneficial for all of us in a number of ways.

- Registrations are open from Mondays to Saturdays before each Sunday service and no registrations can be made on the day of the service. We will keep a record of attendance to be safe.
- If you can't register online and you want to attend you can register through the church office 9341 5572 Monday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday before 12 noon only.

COVID-19 UPDATE

1. Sunday services can still be accessed through our new Facebook page 'Karrinyup Anglican Church Services'. Request an invitation if you are on Facebook and Kevin can give you access. The sermons are still available in audio as well.
2. We can now have up to 100 people attend provided we keep 1.5 metres apart from each other aside from couples and families. The chairs will be spaced accordingly. Communion will still be of one kind and good hygiene should be maintained before, during, between and after services. We will refrain from physical contact for the sharing of the Peace for the time being.
