

## EXERCISES IN FAITH

As Jesus suffered on the cross the four gospels give us seven words Jesus spoke in the lead up to his death. Matthew and Mark record those powerful words from the beginning of Psalm 22, 'My God, my God, why have you forsaken me'. It highlights for us the challenge that faith can be especially in such appalling circumstances as this. More and more faith is seen as something irrational, a denial of our immediate context and circumstances. The scriptures show us faith is fundamentally trust, trusting God or another but the Psalm seems to challenge this.

Psalm 22 starts, at first glance, with a reason to NOT have faith. The psalmist's circumstances imply God has abandoned him and left him to suffer at the hands of his enemies. As we look at the cross of Calvary, an act of supreme injustice, it's no wonder Jesus draws on the Psalm. In our own suffering we forget that Jesus suffered as few people ever did. He is our great high priest in part because he was tempted, harassed and oppressed as every faithful saint has been and then some.

The Psalm as a whole powerfully points to the nature of faith. The Psalmist soon moves from grief and despair to hope and reassurance. He knows what God has done in times gone by and he knows God's will is not to harm but to bless him. Restoration, justification, deliverance will come somehow, someday. Some theologians make much of the separation within the Godhead the moment Jesus died, bearing the sins of the world as if the Godhead itself was sundered. When we look at the Psalm Jesus quoted in its entirety, that's an overstatement. What happened at that moment within God is a profound mystery, but we know Jesus trusted his Father to keep him that beyond his death lay the resurrection declaring to all he is the Son of God. So in the midst of our own suffering, as he had hope, so do we.
