

Keeping Up Appearances

In the early nineties, the BBC series was made featuring Hyacinth Bucket pronounced 'Bouchet' apparently who was all about appearances. Most episodes revolved around her maintaining the charade of being an upper-class lady despite the obvious reality. There are so many ways by which people keep up appearances as paragons of virtue, morality, style, respect and so forth. The religious leaders of Jesus' day were masters at this. They were well-respected across the land and at times courageously stood up against the paganising Romans. Nonetheless, by the time we get to the gospels, it is clear their pre-eminent concern is power and reputation, often transmitted through 'tradition'. The pharisees, in particular, had built up a substantial body of oral tradition to supposedly supplement the Law of Moses. Sadly these traditions had become more important than the very word of God.

This is the challenge when it comes to traditions. At their best, they can be a useful tool to aid us in our relationships whether within the church or within the community. When it comes to expressing our faith in the details, tradition can help us express our faith together in a relevant, ordered and unified manner. On the other hand, traditions, if left unchecked, becomes a means by which we drift into complacency and apathy doing the same thing over and over again as we drift into irrelevancy. At worst they become a means of establishing a closed, cold and unwelcoming community where power is held by the privileged gatekeepers. This is a real challenge for the church. In contrast, Jesus reminds us of the call to live our lives grounded in God's word above all else as we honour him and others.
