

## POINTING FORWARD

Most people will still often refer to the birth of a child as a miracle, an event of such joy and wonder. Over this advent season we will look at four Old Testament figures whose birth or childhood points us forward to the birth of the Lord Jesus. As we think about the relationship between the Old and New Testaments the obvious connection is Jesus, the promises of the Old fulfilled or beginning to be fulfilled in the New. "For all the promises of God find their Yes in Christ" (2 Cor 1:20).

Along with this the connection is prophetic such as we see in the Messianic Psalms (e.g. Psalm 110). We see Old Covenants one after another that eventually take us forward to the New covenant that was ratified with Jesus' death and resurrection, a covenant not written on stone but on the heart by God's Spirit.

Another link is the typological, referred to in the letter to the Hebrews as 'shadows' that find full expression in Christ. So we can speak of Jesus as the second Adam, of a priest in the order of Melchizedek and so forth. In the life of Israel we see three key offices that are prophet, priest and king. All of these and more are fulfilled on Christ, the very Word of God, our Great High Priest and the King of Kings.

So as a result we see Philip tell Nathanael "We have found him of whom Moses in the Law and also the prophets wrote, Jesus of Nazareth," and then invited him to "come and see" the Lord ([John 1:45-47](#)) and the disciples on the Road to Emmaus could speak of their joy after being with Jesus as he "beginning with Moses and all the Prophets, (he) interpreted to them in all the Scriptures the things concerning himself" Luke 24:27.

In all of this we see the God who speaks and does so consistently and truly and who is faithful throughout whether in his word given to the prophets or the apostles and supremely in Christ.
