The Reality of Evil

As we look at this second cycle of trumpets in the book of Revelation, the fifth and sixth trumpets present us gain with the reality and power of evil. The various ways our society pictures ad understands evil has changed over the years. There was a time when it was trivialised, hell pictured as the place where all the partygoers when while the killjoys got bored in heaven. For modernists the devil and his cohorts was a way of explaining the evil and darkness that is humanity's bestial nature especially given more of the destructive natural forces we experience can be explained naturally. More recently evil has been seen as nothing more than a postmodern construct by which we cope with a hostile and unknown universe and society.

The problem is that for many people their experience of evil, especially the evil we see in human being is clearly more than a construct whether Auschwitz, gang and domestic violence, bullying, institutional corruption and so on. The naturalistic explanation is true but I think insufficient given our experience. There is a deeper explanation grounded in a good world God made that evil forces and people distort, pervert and destroy but that God will ultimately redeem and restore in Christ.
