

## The Bible, God's Image, Marriage & Sexuality

First and foremost the Bible speaks to us of our relationship with God our creator and redeemer for whom we were made to enjoy a relationship of love and peace that turned into contempt and discontent. It tells us of the culmination of God's rescue plan that is Jesus Christ crucified and risen through whom the fallen creation will be renewed and restored. The Bible as a consequence tells us something about the nature of our humanity as image bearers made in God's likeness and reminds us that a fundamental aspect of being in that likeness is our being male and female.

Traditional concepts like gender, are being challenged along with the basis for marriage, how we live as single people and questions of sexual conduct and morality. What was extreme is becoming mainstream. Over the next few weeks, we will look at these issues from a biblical perspective. I won't be able to cover every aspect and detail but aim to give us a way forward in the midst of what is becoming a minefield. It has become incredibly political, costing careers and is increasingly divisive as groups do little more than abuse those who disagree with them. We need to stand up for the truth in Christ and to do so with his grace.

At the front door of the church building is a lovely large white cross. This was known as the Canterbury Cross, in the early years, referring to the fact that it was used on the stage of the entertainment centre when the Archbishop of Canterbury, Robert Runcie, visited Perth in February 1988.

After the visit, KAC was offered the cross as we would be the next church to be commissioned. The cross itself was commissioned in May, 1988. The congregation met that morning at KAC for the commissioning and then moved over to the Community Centre for the rest of the service including a couple of Confirmations.
