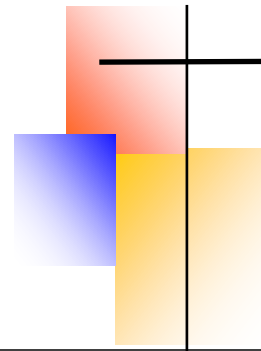

LOOKING BACK, MOVING FORWARD

This week sees two anniversaries, the first significant to me personally and the second to our nation. On Thursday the Bush Church Aid Society turned 103 years old. The same day is also the anniversary for National Sorry day. Both also matter to us as Christians as we think about the heart of our faith that is the Lord Jesus and his death and resurrection.

We've been looking at Acts, at the start of the church and its mission and the changed lives that have resulted. For over a century BCA has been dedicated to that task across outback and rural Australia. It formed because it was committed to the call to proclaim the gospel throughout the world, to every nation and to every corner of this nation. How many lives have been changed and saved through the ministry of BCA, the Bush Brothers, the Aboriginal Inland Mission, Presbyterian Inland Mission and so forth. It was also the time when Christians founded services like the RFDS that sought to care for people practically as well as spiritually across our young nation.

National Sorry Day speaks to the reconciling work of the Cross. As God was at work reconciling the world to him through Christ so we too can be agents of reconciliation in his name. Australian history has its highs and lows and the injustices and evils perpetrated in days gone by cannot be ignored. It will also do us no good to wallow in guilt or shame. Through reconciliation we move forward and as my friend Neville who works for BCA as its indigenous consultant reminded us only through Christ can reconciliation truly come from the heart and change hearts. We are all one in Christ by faith and the love we're called to demonstrate we pray will be seen in our love and care for our first nations brothers and sisters.

COVID REQUIREMENTS FROM DIOCESE

- * 2 sqm rule and 75% patron maximum capacity is removed
- * Masks no longer mandatory while indoors at church but if you for any reason prefer to still wear one please do so. That is simply a matter of choice.
- * Hospitals and Residential aged care and disability care facilities -
 - Masks must still be worn
 - two visitors per patient per day (except for compassionate reasons and essential visitors)
 - Visitors still required to show proof of vaccination
- * Practice good hygiene at all times, on entering the building and before taking communion especially
- * Be mindful during the greeting of the peace of other's preferences especially if they prefer not to make physical contact with others.
- * The collection at both services will happen by means of placing one's gift in the basket up front.
- * If anyone feels unwell or at risk, stay home and if need be get tested ASAP
- * Keep alert for state government requirements.
