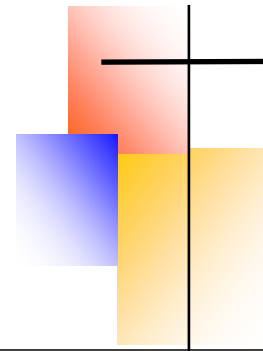

BITTER BETRAYAL; DILIGENT DEVOTION

When we last thought about Judas, it was in the context of his comments to Jesus when Mary broke the perfume over Jesus' feet. Already we know he was tipping into the communal money bag but here we see the heart of the darkness within him as he actively and premeditatedly plans to betray Jesus. I will say more in the sermon about how we consider Judas, his motives and actions but sadly I know for many of us we too have known the sting of betrayal. We may have even fallen into the sorry trap of betraying someone we love in the moment.

Writing about betrayal is a bit like writing about guilt, betrayal can be forced, an accusation, a tool used by the manipulative and damaged to get their own way at the expense of others. Other times it's not so much betrayal as a breakdown in communication, of differing expectations that leads to confusion and hurt or it's good, old-fashioned betrayal when someone deliberately betrays us and causes a world of hurt. When we face such circumstances, we again remember the call to forgiveness but also the way of wisdom and to pray and hope for repentance and change.

The passion narratives though also speak to us of the alternative, of the devotion of the women from Jesus' mother Mary to the others who followed and stayed with Jesus to the end. They grieved, they wept, they hurt but they did not leave him or turn on him. For all of us good communication is an ever-present lesson we keep learning to avoid hurt and confusion where we can. The women though speak to us of the deeper motivation that is faithfulness and loyalty, of honesty and commitment to their Lord and others that is a lesson for us all in the light of Judas' betrayal.
