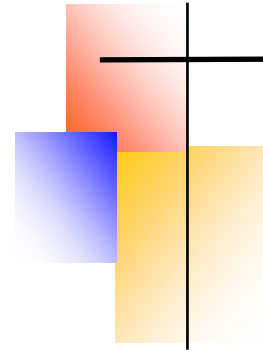

The Power of Hope

One of the most well known verses is of course John 3:16. 'God so love the world that he gave his only Son that whosoever should believe in him will receive eternal life.' Jesus' words encapsulate in simple but powerful terms his mission. We get ready in Advent for the coming of Jesus into the world. His coming marks the beginning of this revelation of love. He comes to show that God has not abandoned us or left us to rot in our suffering and brokenness. The world was a mess but God becomes one of us and enters into that mess.

Nonetheless John 3:16 reminds us that Christmas is only the start. The climax is Easter. God's love is ultimately a holy love, a pure love, a redeeming love. He enters into the messy world in order to save us and to ultimately restore it to what it was and meant to be. The great picture of the Bible is God dwelling with his people, but that relationship was blighted by sin and only Jesus can come to save us. This is our hope that began in Bethlehem long ago.
