Strangers in a Strange Land

For the next few weeks we will be looking at the book of Daniel. There are two main reasons we will look at this familiar yet enigmatic book. The first is that as we see Daniel and his friends' dilemma that the exile generated, how do they continue to exist and express themselves as the people of God in these devastating circumstances? Given the prevailing foreign culture, to what do they acquiesce and what do they avoid?

1 Peter reminds us their challenges are still ours as we wrestle with living in the world but not of it. The book also says much about the nations and God's relationship with them. Our world is seeing remarkable and at times disturbing change. The nations throughout the Old Testament are presented in a variety of ways. No one way fits all. Nonetheless Daniel reminds us as to his present and future God has not lost control, nor is he unaware or uncaring. Ultimately one kingdom will arise over all the others, founded in Daniel's successor, the great wise man Jesus Christ.
