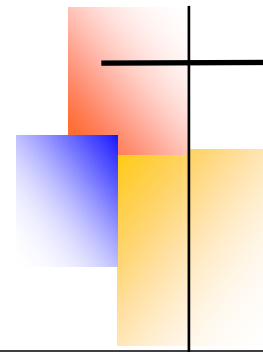

CHRIST IN THE NEW YEAR

Today we think about the visit of the Magi, the Wise Men who saw the star and went in search of the baby Jesus, recognising him to be the newborn King promised long ago. They were the first non-Jewish people to see and worship the Lord Jesus, the first of many. We will also hear today from Frank Nicol and the way the same gospel is being proclaimed in Karratha through the year.

This is the first Sunday of 2021. I know many will be relieved to see the back of 2020, one newspaper saying 'Good Riddance'! We do not know what this year will have in store. Will it be better or worse? COVID is still a very present reality and even with the vaccine coming it reminds us that nature is not something we, in our arrogance, can tame. Some of us will start this New Year processing the last and what we've been through. There is grief to process, lessons to be learnt and possibilities to consider and work towards. In some ways last year was a humbling year for a stressed and overworked world. We can so readily boast in our abilities, accomplishments, status and wealth.

The scriptures though remind us that we are called to be humble, mindful of the God over all things who oversees our ways. James warns us about boasting about tomorrow because we don't know what tomorrow will bring. Paul sought to boast in one thing and one thing only, Jesus Christ crucified and risen. Everything else Paul had or had done was of no more worth than filthy rags. In the face of death Job reminds us we came into the world naked and we leave it naked, nothing but dust. As we look to this next year which will have plenty of challenges, let us look at it with such humble faith, resting and boasting in the Lord Jesus who gave his life that we might live.
