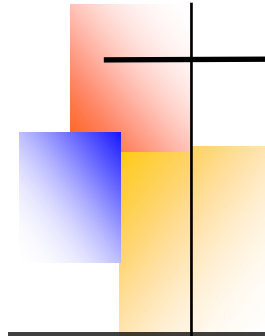

## The Glorious Christ

Today just prior to the beginning of Lent we look at Jesus' transfiguration. After this week in the lead up to Easter at KAC we are going to look at the various aspects of the cross and why it matters. Nonetheless this event recorded in three of the four gospels is one I think we underestimate. I am also sure that this event underpinned much of John's prologue in his gospel as he wrote of Jesus as the Christ, the very Word of God who is God. He too saw him manifest his glory and majesty on the mountain along with James and Peter.

This event is significant for its meaning and timing. For a moment three of the disciples see Jesus fully revealed as God and Man. In Matthew, Mark and Luke it is after this event that Jesus heads towards Jerusalem and the Cross. Only after Jesus' resurrection will the disciples understand the significance of this event as the veil between heaven and earth is pulled back briefly and they see Jesus in his fullness. In some ways it makes their shock at his resurrection unsettling because they should have realized even death could not hold down someone like this.

As John notes it also reminds us Jesus came from elsewhere, from God himself and came to reveal the one true God. Like the resurrection it reminds us Jesus is a human being and yet so much more. That is why we can speak of the call to repent and believe and to follow him no matter the cost, otherwise it truly is all in vain.

### Church Matters

Michael mentioned a few weeks ago that the Diocesan Office were auditing the clearances that are held by each person who holds a responsible position in the running of the church. This includes the counters, prayer ministers, children's workers, welcomer's and so on.

At present we are working through the list that the Diocese has supplied and checking this with our records. It is pleasing to note that all who work with our children have the required Working With Children Check.

We are now working through the people who require a Police Clearance. If you are required to have a Police Clearance and we don't have one on our records for you, I will be contacting you with a form. If you already have a clearance (maybe for your employment) a photocopy of this is all that is required.

There are also a number of people who will be asked to attend a Churchsafe course that is run by the Diocese. When the dates for these are published I will let the relevant people know.

Please note that each of the above Certifications need to be renewed every 3 years but you will be informed of this when the time comes.

Lastly, we are each required to submit a Form 1 to the Diocese, if we hold any responsible position in the church. This is a one off form and I will have copies available for those who need to fill them out.

If you see me heading your way over the next few weeks, please don't feel that you need to run away. I am harmless and the process is not threatening!!!
