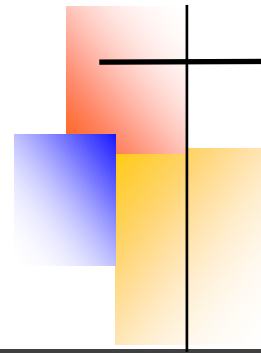

## READING SCRIPTURE: THE DANGER OF MORALISM

When we read the bible, especially the Old Testament it's easy to focus on the central characters and their character whether good or bad. We then take on board the good examples and seek to avoid the bad. King Hezekiah is a great example in this regard. He is a man of faith, but he is also a man with very real failings. There are lessons we can learn from his example both good and bad but that's not the point of the passage nor of the scriptures. Books like Kings reveal for us the ways God is at work through human history in particular Israel's history as he works to restore a broken world.

Today's passage speaks to us of events that testify to God's covenant faithfulness with his people and of the responsibility God's people have to the covenant to respond in faith and obedience. The Kings of Israel and Judah were meant to be the great examples of such conduct as they led God's people in the faith. The prophets served a crucial function as we see in Isaiah as they encouraged or rebuked the king and people as needs be in the face of external threats on the one hand or the infidelity on the other. The priests then served to teach the faith and atone for theirs, the king's and the people's sins when they strayed from the covenant.

In Christ we have the King, the Messiah who also points the way in his example, the Word of God who calls us to know God and live lives of faith and obedience and who also makes the way for us where we cannot through his death and resurrection. It is good to consider the example of those saints who have gone before us, but we do so mindful we are all lost in our sin and it is through the Lord Jesus Christ our saviour king alone that we are found.
