Giving, Grace and God

This week I want us to think anew about our giving here at KAC. Financially we're going okay but we've also seen better days. How do we respond to our present circumstances? Its so easy to talk about giving, whether money or time or energy in the usual ways. I could speak about tithing yet again (which is still a discipline well worth considering as we do) or to speak about how God will bless you in return for your costly generosity. Today though the portion of the book of Numbers we are looking at reminds us yet again giving must be seen in the light of God and his grace.

We experience God's grace in three main ways as the God who i) gave us life, ii) sustains and provides for us materially and spiritually and iii) has redeemed and rescued us in Jesus. The Jewish festivals served to remind Israel of these truths and how they ought to shape their life together. These truths ought to also shape our life together and how we see our money, time and energy. We give and give generously because God has given us so much in the Lord Jesus.
