THE COURAGE OF OUR CONVICTIONS

This last week we have remembered the ANZACs who fought and died for our nation in two world wars and various conflicts beginning with Gallipoli. We rightly remember their courage and sacrifice. Such courage I think rises out of a conviction that there are ideals, values and principles that are universal and worth standing up, fighting and dying for if need be. They gave their lives for their families, their country and its way of life, for freedom and peace.

Considering the last few chapters of Acts and the events that lead Paul to Rome, one of the things that stands out is his courage. It stands as something grounded in convictions about reality, truths and principles beyond ourselves. For Paul and the Apostles collectively who were martyred or exiled such courage was grounded in the gospel, in Jesus Christ, incarnate, crucified and risen. They were willing to give up all, as many of our brethren are doing today, because of that truth and reality. I find Paul's courage a challenge and a reminder. The light does shine in the darkness and the darkness will try to overcome it but ultimately to no avail.
