

Building a Strong Foundation

In a few days time we usher in a New Year. Some people are in the habit of making New Year resolutions but I am not one of those. Nonetheless as we leave one year behind and head into another I want to encourage you to read an orthodox book on Christian theology. More and more the notion of theology or doctrine is dismissed as a conceited human exercise but there is so much more to it than that. Good theology seeks to understand and apply the gospel and the spiritual and ethical ideas and principles that surround it to the world in which it exists. Good theology seeks to do justice to God's revealed word written and incarnate and to apply it relevantly in the immediate circumstances in which we live.

Like wisdom, good theology acknowledges the insights we gain about the world, society and culture that aid our understanding and application of the gospel and God's word. Reason, experience and tradition do not stand over it but at their best serve as helpers. Good theology also recognises and considers the insights of those who have gone before us whether the Church Fathers, medieval, reformation and post-reformation theologians who sought to live lives faithfully to God, Father, Son and Holy Spirit. So take the time to find and read something like 'Know the Truth' by Bruce Milne or 'Knowing God' by J.I.Packer. There are also other books that serve to inform the Christians about the essentials that undergird and fill out understanding of the gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ as we head into the New Year and seek to serve and follow him in faith, love and grace.
