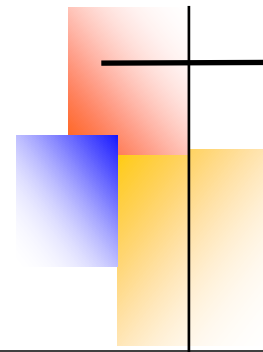

### THE COVID CHALLENGE: WHAT NOW?

It's been about two years since the spectre of COVID-19 raised its head and changed the world. Since then vaccines have been made, pills are on the way and all the while, like many viruses COVID mutates. Even more urgently, the omicron variant is slowly spreading around Perth and the state. As a consequence please get fully vaccinated as my family is.

So at this stage the following apply as they have for a while:

If you are not feeling well especially with any kind of respiratory illness, don't come to church and, if need be, get tested as soon as possible, especially if you have been at a hot spot or in contact with someone who may have caught COVID.

Always practice good hygiene. Make use of hand gel whenever you need to, refrain from physical contact if need be and wear a face mask indoors for any church meeting unless eating or drinking.

QR Codes: When coming to church please use the relevant SafeWA app on your phone or write your basic details on the sign in sheet which is always near the front door.

There are no strict requirements at the moment with regards to social distancing but again if need be keep your distance.

At this moment given the present surge in cases the state government is reassessing various measures and definitions. When we know more, we will let you know.

Why are these measures required? In part because they are legal requirements that mean incurring legal and financial penalties if not adhered to. More importantly it's about caring for one another and especially the more vulnerable members of our church. We want church to be a safe place as much as possible. Beyond these things we live with hope in the crucified and risen Lord who has given us the gift of eternal life and gives us no reason to live in dread.
